

Terms and Conditions for Entry to WACSSO 2025 Conference

WACSSO (The Organiser)

You (attendee)

Registration and Entry Requirements: All attendees must have a valid registration to attend and must present to the registration desk upon arrival at the conference venue. Entry may be refused if the attendee is not registered to attend Conference.

Cancellation policy: If you need to cancel your registration, please notify us in writing before 5pm on 21 July and a refund, minus a 25% processing fee, will be issued. **Cancellations made after 5pm on 21 July will not be eligible for a refund.** A change of name is accepted until 48 hours prior to Conference commencement, however changes made less than 14 days prior to Conference will result in the conference identification badge reflecting the original booking name - this can be altered manually at registration.

If you are a no-show (that is, you do not cancel but you do not attend) you agree to reimburse WACSSO for the sponsored portion of your ticket(s)*. The right for WACSSO to decline ticket and travel sponsorship for future conferences is reserved for registered delegates with subsidised or sponsored tickets who are no-shows.

*If your ticket has been partially subsidised by WACSSO, please keep in mind that WACSSO reserves the right to request partial reimbursement of the subsidy if you do not attend Sunday morning of Conference.

Code of Conduct: All attendees must behave in a professional and respectful manner towards other attendees, speakers, exhibitors and event staff. Any form of harassment, discrimination, or inappropriate behaviour including disrupting proceedings will not be tolerated and may result in the attendee being asked to leave the conference without a refund.

Recording and Photography: No audio or video recording of conference sessions is allowed without prior written consent from the organisers. Photography is allowed but must not be disruptive to the conference proceedings. Attendees should respect the privacy and preferences of other attendees regarding photography and filming.

Photography and Promotional Use: By attending this event, attendees acknowledge that photographs, video or audio recordings may be taken during the course of the event. These images and recordings may be used by the event organisers for promotional and marketing purposes, including (but not limited to) use on websites, social media, printed materials, and future event promotions.

If you do not wish for your image or likeness to be used, please notify the event organisers during the conference registration process. Reasonable efforts will be made to accommodate such requests.

Intellectual Property: The content presented at the conference, including but not limited to presentations, materials, and recordings, are the intellectual property of the organisers or their respective owners. Attendees may not copy, distribute, nor use any Conference content without prior written consent from the organisers. Where possible, slides or presentations will be made available to the attendees with the permission of the creators.

Liability: The organisers will not be liable for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by attendees at the conference, including but not limited to loss of property, personal injury, or illness. Attendees are responsible for their own safety and well-being during the conference.

Changes and Cancellations: The organisers reserve the right to change the program, venue, timing, date, or any other aspect of the conference without prior notice.

Accommodation Responsibility: Where the event organiser is acting as guarantor for accommodation bookings on behalf of attendees, any costs arising from damage to the accommodation property, additional cleaning fees, or other charges incurred as a result of the attendee's stay will be the responsibility of the attendee. These costs will be passed on to the attendee, who agrees to reimburse the event organiser in full upon request.

Data Privacy: By registering for the WACSSO Conference, you consent to WACSSO collecting and using your personal information for purposes related to planning, delivering, and improving the event experience. This includes sharing your contact details with trusted third parties directly involved in the conference, such as event vendors, sponsors, and service providers. WACSSO will not use your information for unrelated purposes. If you have specific concerns about your information being shared, please contact us prior to registering to discuss your options..

By purchasing a ticket, attendees agree to abide by these terms and conditions. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry or remove attendees who fail to comply with these terms and conditions or whose behaviour is deemed inappropriate. The organiser shall not be liable for any delay or failure to perform its obligations under these terms if such delay is due to a Force Majeure event including but not limited to natural disasters, war, pandemic, government restrictions, or venue unavailability.

Terms and Conditions for Receiving a Prize at the 2025 WACSSO Conference

Eligibility: Participants must meet the eligibility criteria as specified by the organiser to be eligible to receive the prize. i.e. – you must be in the room at the time the prize is awarded.

Transfer: While Participants may personally keep any prizes that were specifically awarded to them, Participants agree to transfer any prizes that were specifically awarded to their P&C. This distinction will be made clear at the time the prize is awarded.

Prize Redemption: The prize must be redeemed as specified by the organiser, and the winner must provide all necessary information and documentation required for prize redemption.

No Refunds or Returns: The prize cannot be refunded or returned once it has been accepted by the winner.

No Cash Value: The prize cannot be exchanged for cash or any other form of compensation. In the event it is a cash prize being awarded the prize money will be deposited in the bank of the applicable organisation. Ie: The registered P&C.

Prize Substitution: The organiser reserves the right to substitute the prize with a prize of equal value if the original prize becomes unavailable.

Taxes and Fees: The winner is solely responsible for any taxes or fees associated with accepting the prize.

Liability: The organiser will not be liable for any loss, damage, or injury incurred by the winner or any third party in connection with the prize.

Publicity: By accepting the prize, the winner agrees to participate in any promotional activities or publicity related to the prize, including but not limited to interviews and photos.

Termination: The organiser reserves the right to terminate the prize or modify the terms and conditions of the prize at any time without notice.

Law: These terms and conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Western Australia in which the organiser and the prize draw is located and the relevant racing and gaming legislation at the time of the prize draw.

By accepting the prize, the winner agrees to abide by these terms and conditions. The prize provider reserves the right to disqualify any winner who fails to comply with these terms and conditions or engages in fraudulent or inappropriate behaviour.
